
# CATHOLIC COMMUNITY AT STANFORD SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER—APRIL 16, 2023

*Priest:* The Lord be with you (or similar greeting).


**People:** And with your spirit.

**People:** May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of


his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church.

Priest: Deliver us, Lord, we pray...Jesus Christ.


*People:* For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and forever.

Priest: Let us offer each other the sign of peace.




#### **Invitation to Communion**


